We make sure that this happens by following these simple rules:

- When the bell is rung in the playground, we stand still, on the second bell we walk quietly and sensibly to our lines and wait for the teacher to take us into our classroom.
- We are escorted by an adult to the dinner hall, and we remain calm at all times.
- We always try our best, and ask for help when we need it.
- When we enter the classroom, we stand behind our chairs silently.
- Walk down corridors, to the left, in a quiet manner.
- We listen carefully and talk politely to ALL adults in school.
- We follow instructions given by adults the first time they ask.
- All school equipment and other children's property is to be treated responsibly and with respect.
- We keep our hands and feet to ourselves at all times.
- Politeness and good manners are expected by ALL members of the school community.
- We must ask permission to enter school during break and dinner times.



We never accept:

- Bullying
- Racism
- Sexism
- Transphobia, biphobia and homophobia
- Violence

Attendance



We expect you to:

- attend school every day (unless you are poorly)
- arrive on time with all the appropriate equipment.

Behaviour in lessons

We expect all children to:

- arrive promptly at the start of lessons
- work sensibly in lessons to the best of their ability
- not prevent other children from learning, or the teacher from teaching;
- complete homework on time and to the best of their ability.



Behaviour in the playground

We expect all children to:

- play peacefully and safely
- follow the guidelines in the basic behaviour rules set out above
- not behave violently, or to bully others in any way



Behaviour at lunchtime

We expect all children to:

- follow the guidelines in the basic behaviour rules;



- follow the routines in the dining room safely, peacefully and quietly

Violence and bullying

We expect that:

- there will be no physical violence between any members of the school community;
- verbal bullying will be treated as seriously as physical violence;
- persistent teasing will be treated seriously;
- no discriminatory language will be used;
- nobody at school will, by their purposeful actions, upset other members of the school
- children will be able to move about the school and its grounds safely without feeling afraid
- they will be able to move to and from school safely without feeling afraid
- they will maintain proper standards of behaviour on their way to and from school.

Rewards for good behaviour

You may receive:

- House points, stickers, treats, class rewards, certificates, non-uniform days

Consequences for poor behaviour

You may receive:

- Loss of rewards, missed playtime, phone call home.

For poor behaviour that continues, you may receive:

- Code of Conduct letter home and in school file, parents coming in to school, removal from class. For really serious behaviour you may be suspended or excluded from school.
