Dear Parents/Carers

On Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> April and Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May 2026, we will be taking our **Year 3/4** classes to visit a local working farm as part of our topic, "Where Does Our Food Come From?" The children will spend some time at Higher Plainsteads Farm near Charlesworth with local farmer Sally Hodgson, learning about how the sheep farm is run by Sally and her family.

Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May – **all year 4 children**

Children will need to bring their Forest School clothes on the day (wellies/boots and waterproof coat and over trousers). The children will be having their lunch at school as normal and will return to school by home time. Information about music lessons, which would usually be on this day, will be confirmed nearer to the date.

The cost of the coach travel to and from the farm is **£6.97** per child to be paid on ParentPay. As always, payment is voluntary but if we do not receive enough contributions, the trip will not go ahead. Our visit to the farm is provided free of charge thanks to Natural England who sponsor Sally to provide educational visits for children.
